**Woman:** Hello! What's your name?

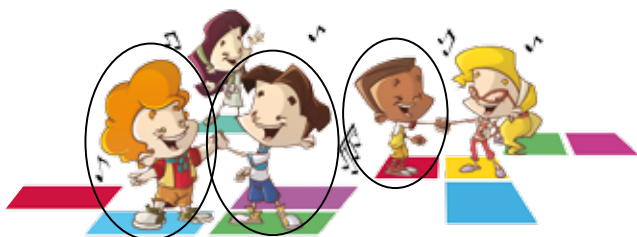
**Boy:** Hi! I'm Brian!

The children paint the pictures red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple.

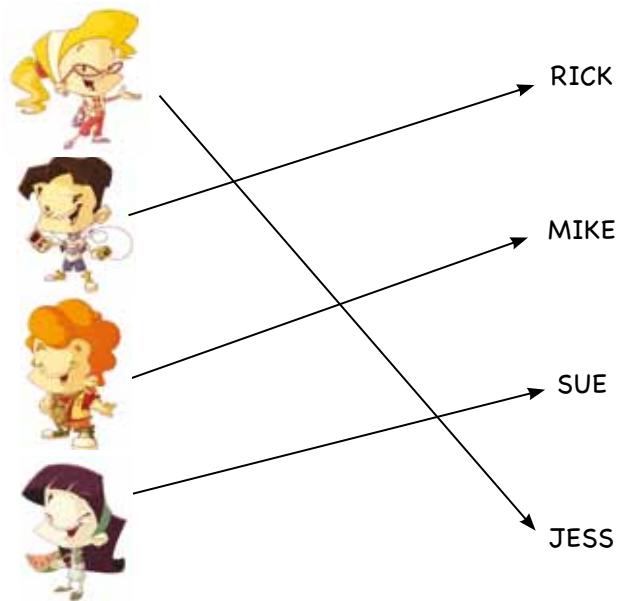
- 2 Tell the children to cut out magazine pictures containing three of the colours studied and glue them in the boxes. Encourage them to say the colours aloud.

## 3 Shapes

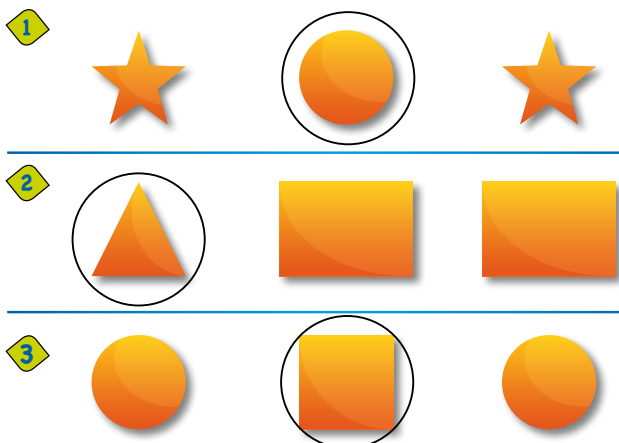

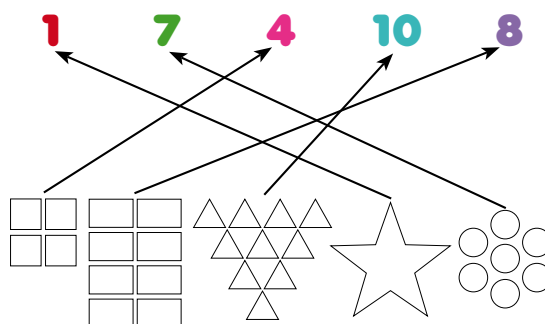
1 Tell the children to count the pictures in each box and write down the figure.

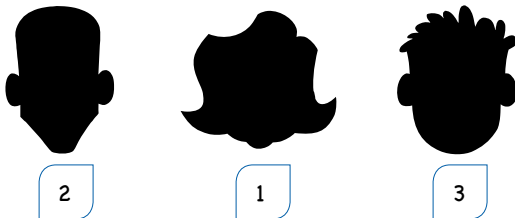

## 7 Let's play!

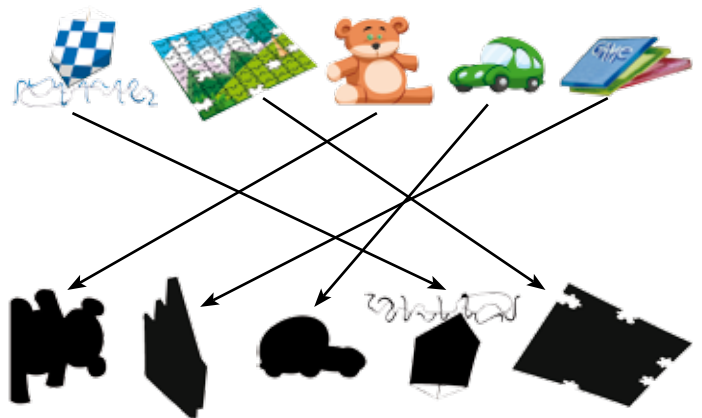
- 1 Tell the children to draw the toys you mention.

## 8 My schoolbag

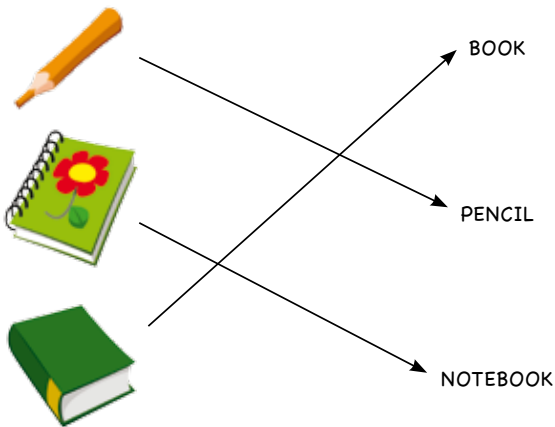

## 10 Breakfast time

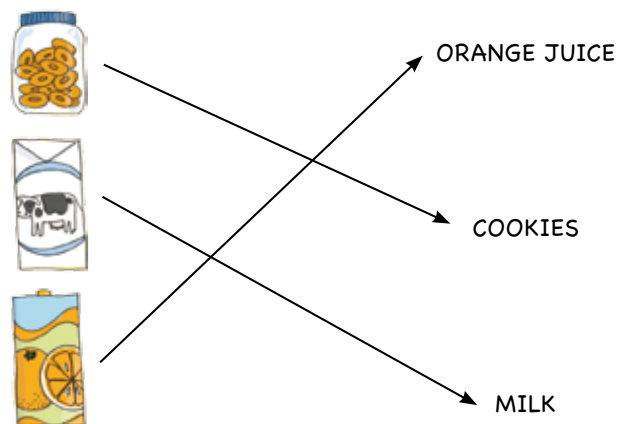
- 1 Tell the children to look at the elements in the first picture and draw the missing items in each of the sets below.
