WEATHER WHEEL - UNIT 2


Material

- ◆ Cardboard template copies
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ Colour pencils
- ◆ Split pin

- Review the weather vocabulary with the children.
- ◆ Hand out the template copies. Tell the children to paint the smaller circle and the hands and then to cut down all the pieces.
- ◆ Help them assemble the weather wheel by placing the bigger circle under the smaller one and the clock hands on top. Use the split pin to hold all the pieces together.

VALENTINE'S DAY

Material


- ◆ Template copies
- ◆ Colour pencils or crayons
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ White glue
- Metal wire or twist ties for sliced bread bags
- ◆ Pencil (to assemble the butterfly)


- ◆ Tell the children you will make a gift for Valentine's Day. Explain Valentine's Day is a time when people show feelings of love, affection and friendship to each other. It is celebrated in many ways worldwide and falls on February 14 each year.
- ◆ Explain the meaning of love bug.
- ◆ Hand out template copies and ask the children to paint and cut the pieces. (Watch out! The eyes must stay together in one piece only after being cut.)
- ◆ Help the children assemble the butterfly: wind the metal wire or twist tie at the top of the pencil making sure the ends are loose. They represent the antennae. Then glue the eyes to the metal wire wound on the pencil. Finally, glue the pencil to the butterfly wings.


EASTER

Material


- ◆ Cardboard template copies
- ◆ Colour felt-tip pens or pencils
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ Glue stick
- ◆ Cotton ball

- ◆ Explain to the children they will assemble an *Easter basket* to hold chocolates or skittles.
- ◆ Review the vocabulary related to Easter with the children and introduce them to new words and phrases: Easter basket, Easter bunny, Easter eggs, chocolate and candles.
- ◆ Hand out template copies to the children, ask them to paint the bunny and basket pictures as desired and cut down all the pieces.
- ◆ Help them assemble the basket, mount the handle and glue the cotton ball as if it were the rabbit's tail.


MOTHER'S DAY

Material

- ◆ Template copies
- ◆ Child's small photo (3 x 4 cm)
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ Colour felt-tip pens
- ◆ White glue
- ◆ Coloured ribbon piece (15 cm)
- ◆ Brochette wooden stick
- ◆ Green watercolour paint
- ◆ 6-cm diametre ceramic vase
- ◆ Candy pills for the vase

- ◆ Explain to the children they will decorate a vase for their mums for *Mother's Day*.
- ◆ Hand out template copies and ask the children to paint the pieces any way they want and then cut them down.
- ◆ Now tell them to glue the photo on the flower button.
- ◆ Help the children paint the brochette wooden stick with green watercolour paint.
- ◆ Ask them to glue the flower and the leaf to the stick once the paint is dry.
- ◆ After that, tell them to fill the vase with candy pills and place the flower.
- ◆ Help them tie in the coloured ribbon piece around the vase.

FATHER'S DAY


Material


- ◆ Cardboard template copies
- ◆ White glue
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ Colour felt-tip pens and pencils
- ◆ Nylon or cotton thread (30 cm)
- ◆ Plastic or metal ring
- ◆ Coloured bead

- ◆ Explain to the children that they will make a mobile for their dads for *Father's Day*.
- ◆ Hand out template copies and ask the children to paint and then cut down the letters.
- ◆ Help them glue the stars to the cotton or nylon thread forming the phrase: BEST ♥ DAD vertically.
- ◆ Tell them to tie the end of the thread to the metal or plastic ring.
- ◆ Finally, instruct them to tie the bead to the other end of the thread to finish the mobile.

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
CHRISTMAS

Material

- ◆ Template copies
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ White glue
- ◆ Colour felt-tip pens and crayons
- ◆ Sequins
- ◆ Cotton

- ◆ Explain to the children they will make a *Christmas* angel to decorate their classroom for Christmas.
- Hand out template copies and ask the children to paint the pieces with colour felt-tip pens and crayons and decorate them with sequins and cotton in the wings
- ◆ Tell them to cut and glue the pieces to form the angel.

GRATITUDE MEDAL

Material

- ◆ Template copies
- ◆ Round tip pair of scissors
- ◆ Colour felt-tip pens and crayons
- ◆ Double-sided adhesive tape to glue to the back of the medal

- ◆ Explain to the children they will make a special gift: a *Gratitude medal* to be given to someone as a sign of gratitude.
- ◆ Discuss with the children about gratitude and mention everyday situations when we feel grateful to other people.
- ◆ Hand out template copies to the children and ask them to paint the medal any colour they want. Then they will have to cut it and write their names on it.
- ◆ Hand out 10 centimetres of double-sided adhesive tape to each child for them to glue to the back of the medal.
- ◆ Instruct them to give the medal to a person the feel grateful to and place it on his / her chest.
