## WHY IS CULTURE IMPORTANT?

In addition to reading, writing, speaking and listening, students should develop cultural skills. In a globalised world where people use social networks as part of their daily routines, it is important for kids to achieve the intercultural competence that will help them when they become adults.

In this section there are photocopiable materials available on some local and also foreign festivals for each of the three levels of the *Fun Way* course. Each teacher can make the activities as creative as they wish and use them as an opportunity to discuss –always in a respectful manner- different cultures across the world.

Learners will also find:

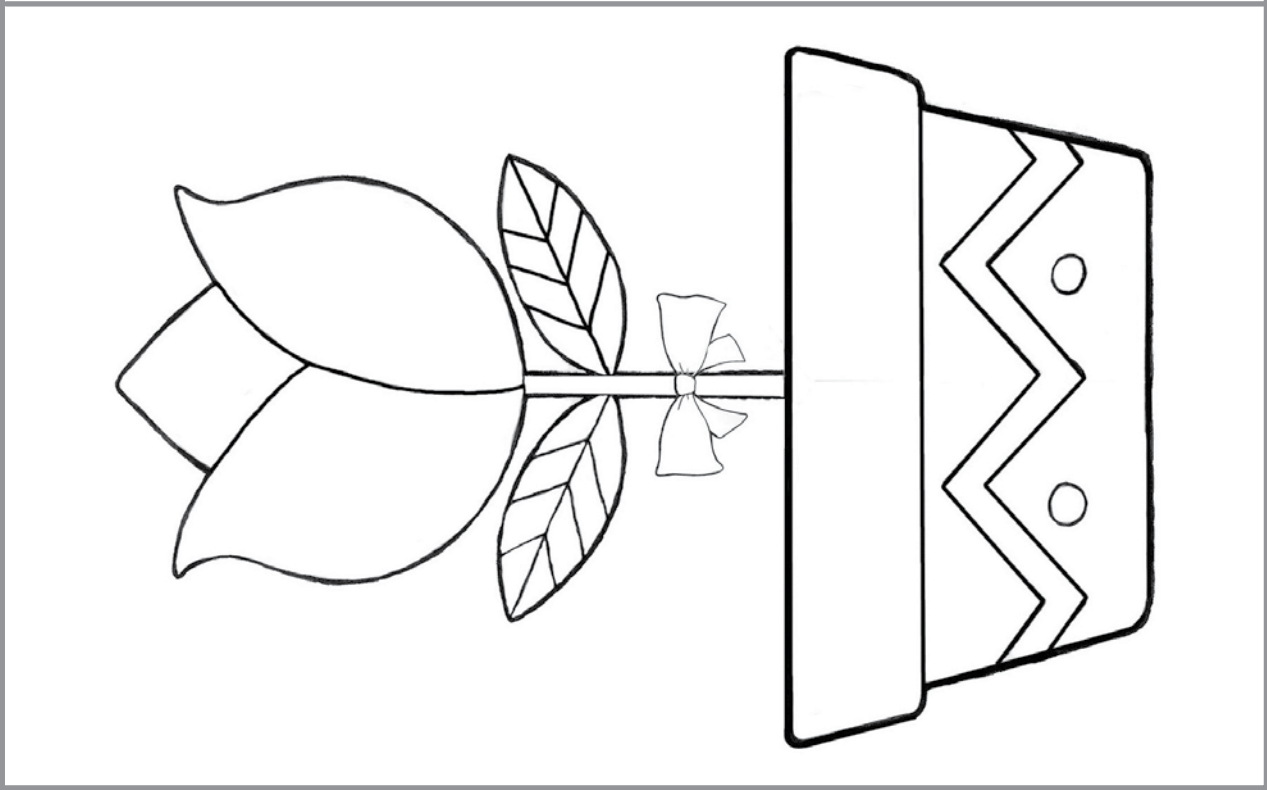
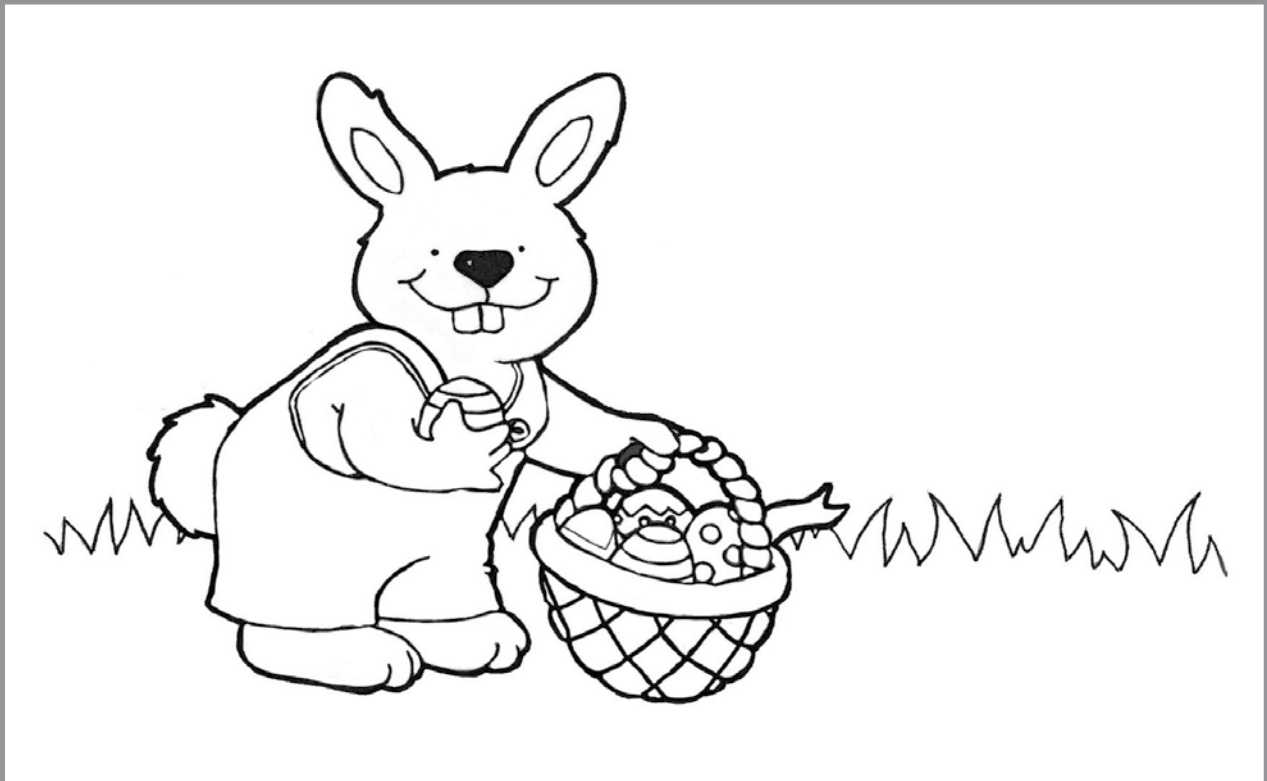
- Optional general themes (*I love you* cards)
